#### RESERVATION DEPOSIT / DRAW ACCOUNT CHARGES

The reservation deposit is credited in full to your draw account and debited monthly for payment of Cadet charges, textbooks, and Cadet pay call. The reservation deposit / draw account must be replenished annually.

## **FORM OF PAYMENT**

The Academy accepts personal checks drawn on US banks in US dollars, electronic bank transfers in US dollars, money orders, and cashier's checks. Please make checks or electronic bank transfer documents payable to the Marine Military Academy. Please note the name of the cadet on the check or electronic funds transfer document. The Academy accepts credit cards (American Express, Discover, MasterCard, Visa). A 3% fee is added to all credit card payments processed directly through the Academy. The Academy also accepts cash.

#### **EXPLANATION OF TUITION AND FEES**

**Application Fee:** This is a one-time, non-refundable fee to cover the administrative costs. Processing of the application will not commence until the application fee is received by the Academy.

**Reservation Deposit / Draw Account:** When the applicant is accepted for enrollment, an enrollment contract will be forwarded to you for signature. To reserve a place on the Cadet roster, the contract must be returned together with the \$1,800.00 reservation deposit (\$1,050.00 for mid-term enrollment) 30 days from acceptance confirmation or as indicated by the "date due." The enrollment contract may be rescinded, and the reservation deposit will be refunded **only** upon written notice to the Academy postmarked, emailed, or faxed no later than the 1st of July for Fall enrollment or the 15th of December for mid-term enrollment. Failure to provide timely notice will result in forfeiture of the deposit.

The deposit is credited to your draw account and applied toward payment of Cadet special fees and charges, and elective fees and charges monthly. Should the draw account be depleted before the end of the school year, Cadet special fees and charges and elective fees and charges are thereafter payable upon receipt of each monthly statement. Any remaining draw account balance is refunded after graduation or upon completion of the contract term for non-returning Cadets. For a re-enrolled Cadet, the draw account must be replenished no later than 1 July for the upcoming academic year. Enrollment at the Academy is a commitment through the end of the academic year. Withdrawal after the first school day will result in forfeiture of the deposit. (See Enrollment Contract or Re-Enrollment Contract and Refund Policy for terms and details of tuition refunds.)

**Uniform Fee:** It is important to distinguish between Academy Issue and Marine Corps JROTC issue. Uniforms issued by the Academy, which include dress blues, become the property of the Cadet. JROTC items MUST be returned to the Quartermaster. Failure to return JROTC uniform items will result in charges against your account for replacement.

#### Flight Training Electives:

Aerospace Courses I (Academic Year) - A two semester ground and flight training course that prepares students to pass the FAA check ride, oral exam, and Airmen/Pilot Knowledge Test. It requires students to be at least 16 years of age and either a US citizenship or TSA approval non-US citizens. Aerospace I must be completed before taking Aerospace II.

**Aerospace Courses II (Academic Year) -** A two semester ground and flight training afterschool activity. Aerospace I must be completed before taking Aerospace II.

### **IMPORTANT DATES**

Students of Foreign Nationality: Please allow no less than 30 days from the date of acceptance for processing the International Student Visa (Form I-20). A completed Form I-20 is required at registration. As a courtesy to our parents, MMA will process the required I901 SEVIS Receipt that accompanies the I20, fee is \$350.00. This is a government allotted fee, NOT MMA's.

**Registration Dates**: Formal registration for new Cadets will be held on Saturday, 17 August 2024 between 0800 – 1200 noon. For returning Cadets invited to Leadership Orientation, check-in will be on 11 August 2024 by 1800. Returning Cadets NOT participating in Leadership Orientation must report on Sunday, 18 August 2024 by 1800. Leadership Orientation is by invitation only.

**Football Training**: Football Training Camp check-in will be on 11 August 2024 by 1800. New Cadets with previous football experience that wish to be a part of the football team are encouraged to check-in on this date. All tuition and fees must be paid in advance of the Cadet's arrival date.

Travel Arrangements: All cadet travel arrangements must be made and paid for by the parent or guardian.
